


We will begin our tour through the Museum with all of their beautiful collectibles, including automobiles that have been acquired by J.B. Nethercutt.

Ferrari celebrates Formula 1 Championship

Maranello, October 20, 2003 - Ferrari SpA

One week after the Japanese Grand Prix, where Scuderia Ferrari took its fifth consecutive Constructor's title and Michael his sixth Driver's World championship crown, the entire Ferrari family got together at Mugello to celebrate.

On Sunday, over 50,000 fans partied in honor of the Red's achievement during the 2003 Ferrari-Maserati World Finals. Michael was joined at the Tuscan circuit by Rubens Barrichello, Luca Badoer and Felipe Massa to put on a magnificent show for all the fans. Also present on the day at Mugello were Ferrari President, Luca di Montezemolo and the Managing Director of the Gestione Sportiva, Jean Todt, along with Ross Brawn, Rory Byrne and Paolo Martinelli, to celebrate one more time the great results achieved this season. "This day and this celebration is just to say thank you to our most faithful fans," said Michael. "They have supported and motivated us in the most difficult of times and for this reason, celebrating alongside them makes us even happier."

This was Michael's first appearance since taking that historic record in Suzuka. As could be expected therefore, the press was keen to know his feeling about this achievement had affected his life. "In some ways, the events at Suzuka seem a long way ago and over now," said Schumacher. "However, when I am at home relaxing, naturally my thoughts return to that day. But everyday life soon returns as I live a very normal existence at home. Corinna and I have two children and they currently represent my present life. In general, I take very little interest in the past and much more in the future. Nevertheless, I cannot deny that what happened in Japan was something fantastic."


Calling all girls who want to show the boys how it's done!



612 Scaglietti

Ferrari has announced the name for its all-new 2+2 model, the 612 Scaglietti, which goes on sale next year.

Named after famous Ferrari coachbuilder Sergio Scaglietti, the all-aluminium 612 will blend performance and comfort "in the best traditions of a true Ferrari berlinetta designed to accommodate four people in high-speed luxury and safety."

For the first time, Ferrari will manufacture a 12-cylinder model with both the space-frame chassis and body panels in aluminium, built in-house at Modena, in the dedicated Scaglietti light-alloy technologies facility. The benefits of this construction method include a 60% increase in structural rigidity and significant weight savings compared to the current 456M GTA – despite the new car's larger dimensions.

The overall layout – engine mounted behind the front axle, gearbox in unit with the differential at the rear – ensures an ideally balanced weight distribution (46% front, 54% rear), as well as permitting a lower center of gravity.

Sergio Scaglietti bodied some of the most beautiful cars ever to emerge from Maranello such as the pontoon fendered 250 Testarossa and the 250 GTO. Scaglietti wasn't a man who relied on pencil and paper to create his magnificent designs: he worked like a sculptor, fashioning their forms from aluminium. And now Luca di Montezemolo honors the understated yet historically important all-aluminium 612 to the memory of that great designer. **SF**



